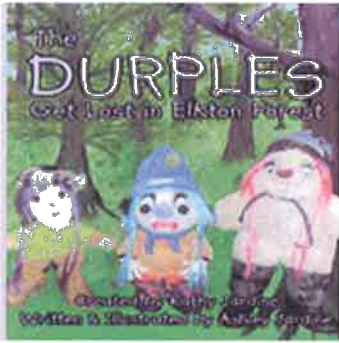
Thank you to all of the people who work everyday to ensure the success of our students. Keep up the great work!
